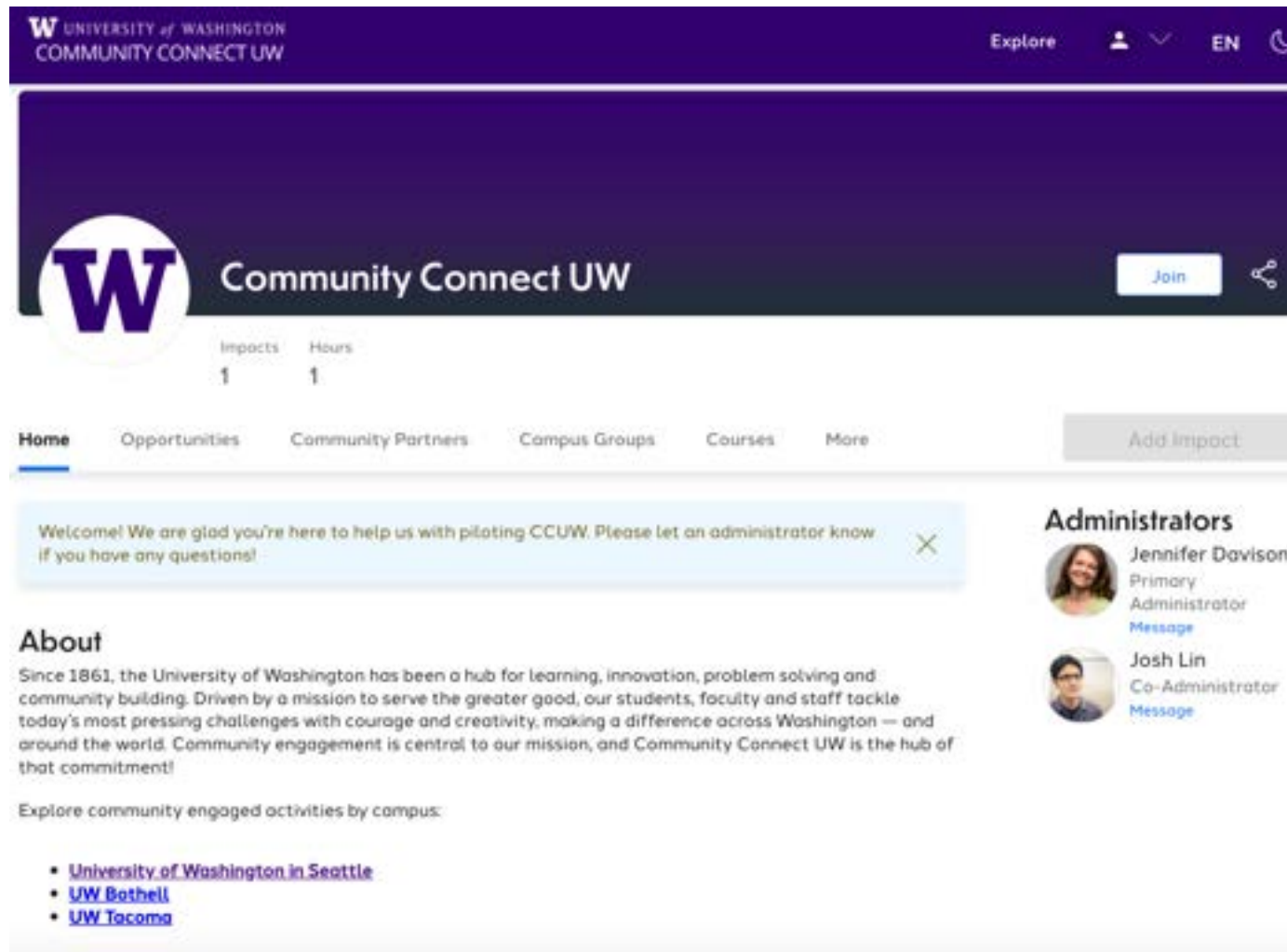


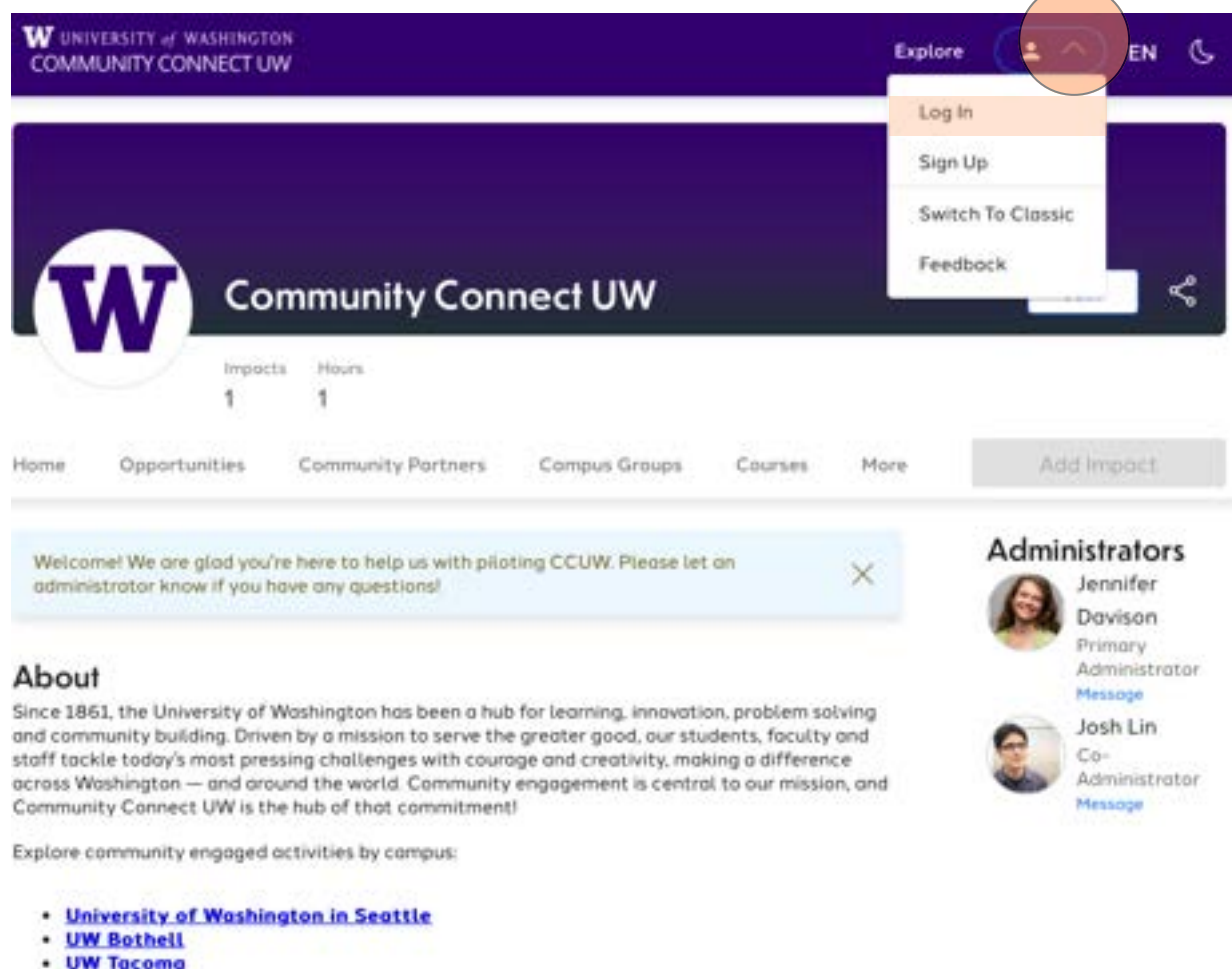


How to: Register for a Community Engagement Opportunity

1 Navigate to uw.givepulse.com (Community Connect UW)

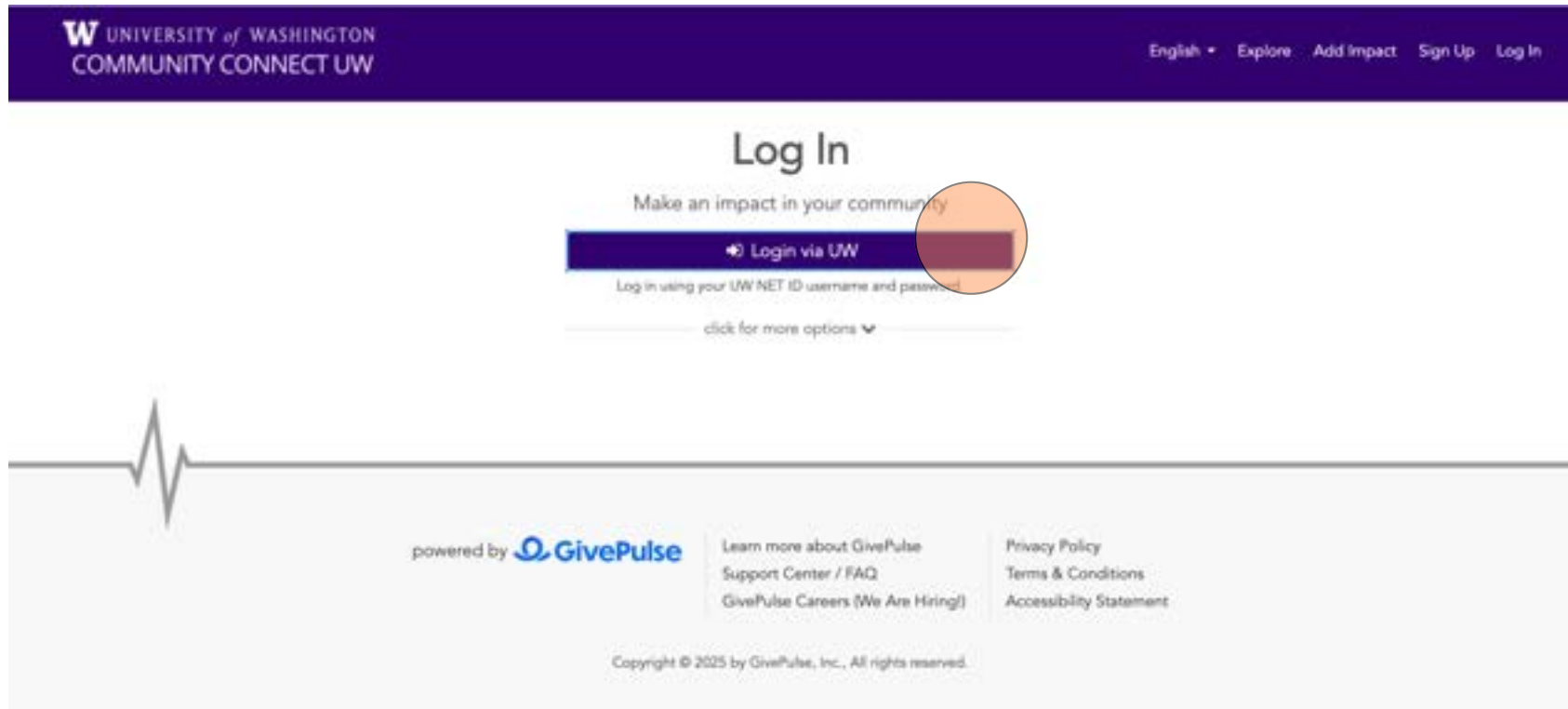


2 Go to the top-right corner, click the profile icon, and choose “Log In” from the dropdown list.



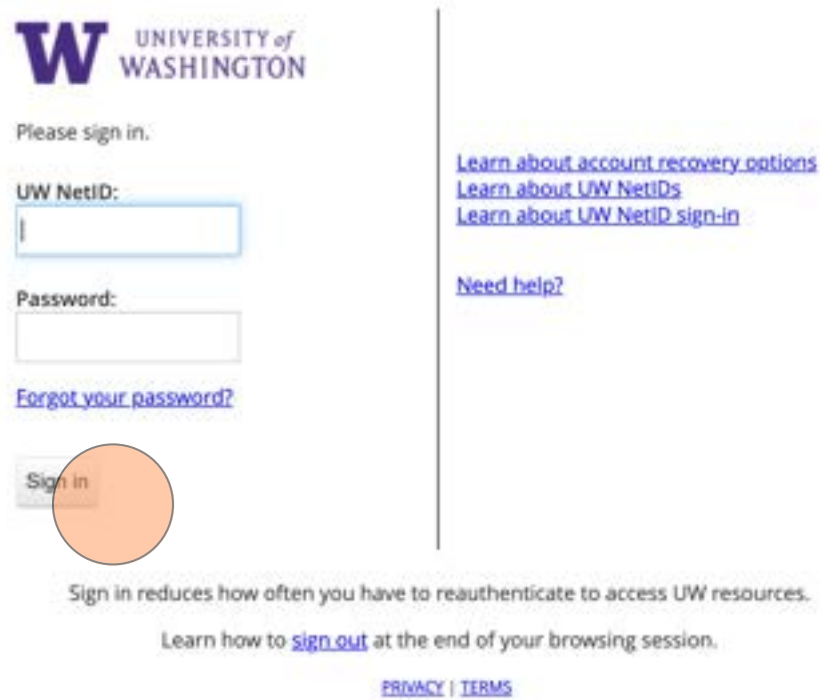

Click “Login via UW”

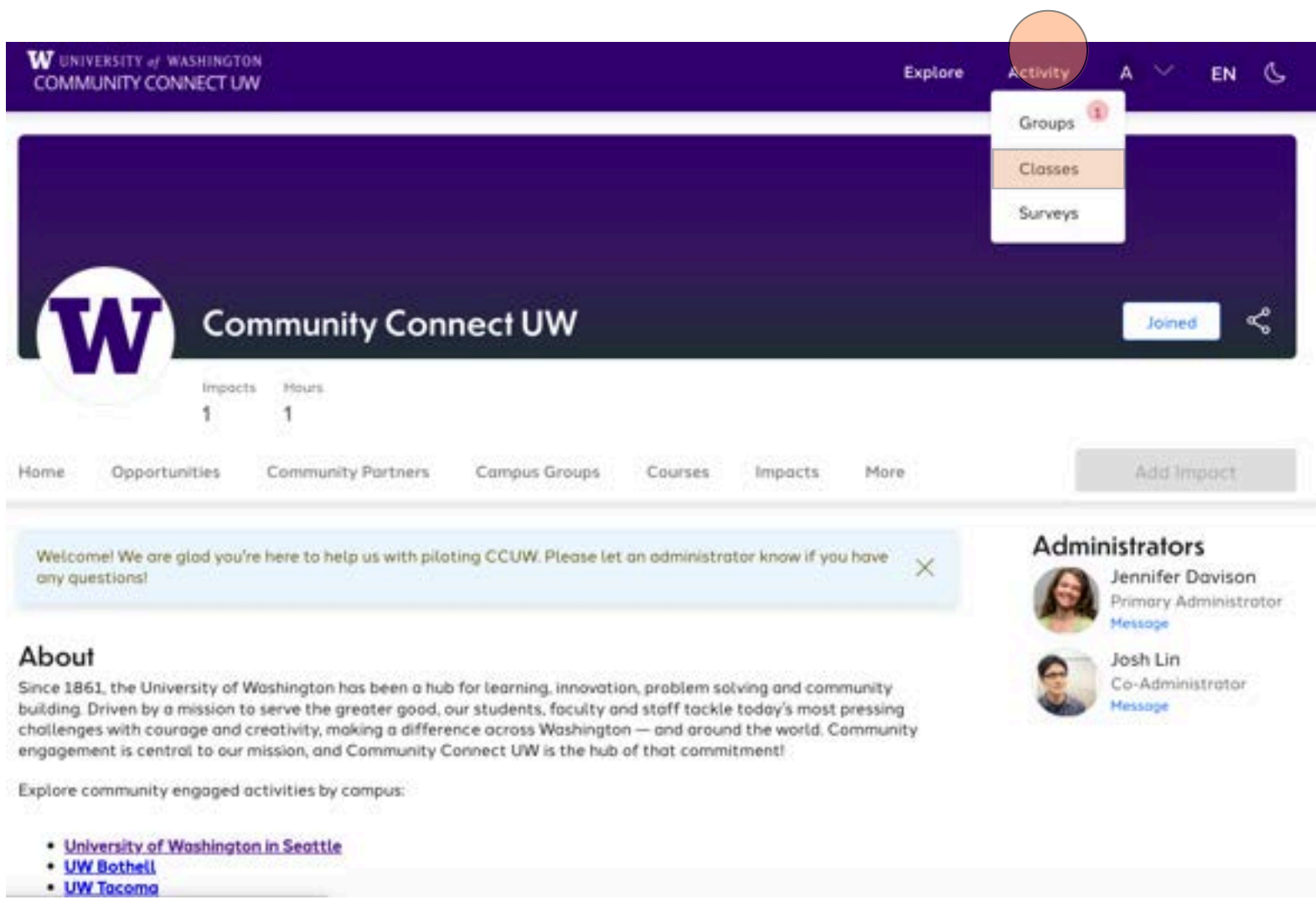

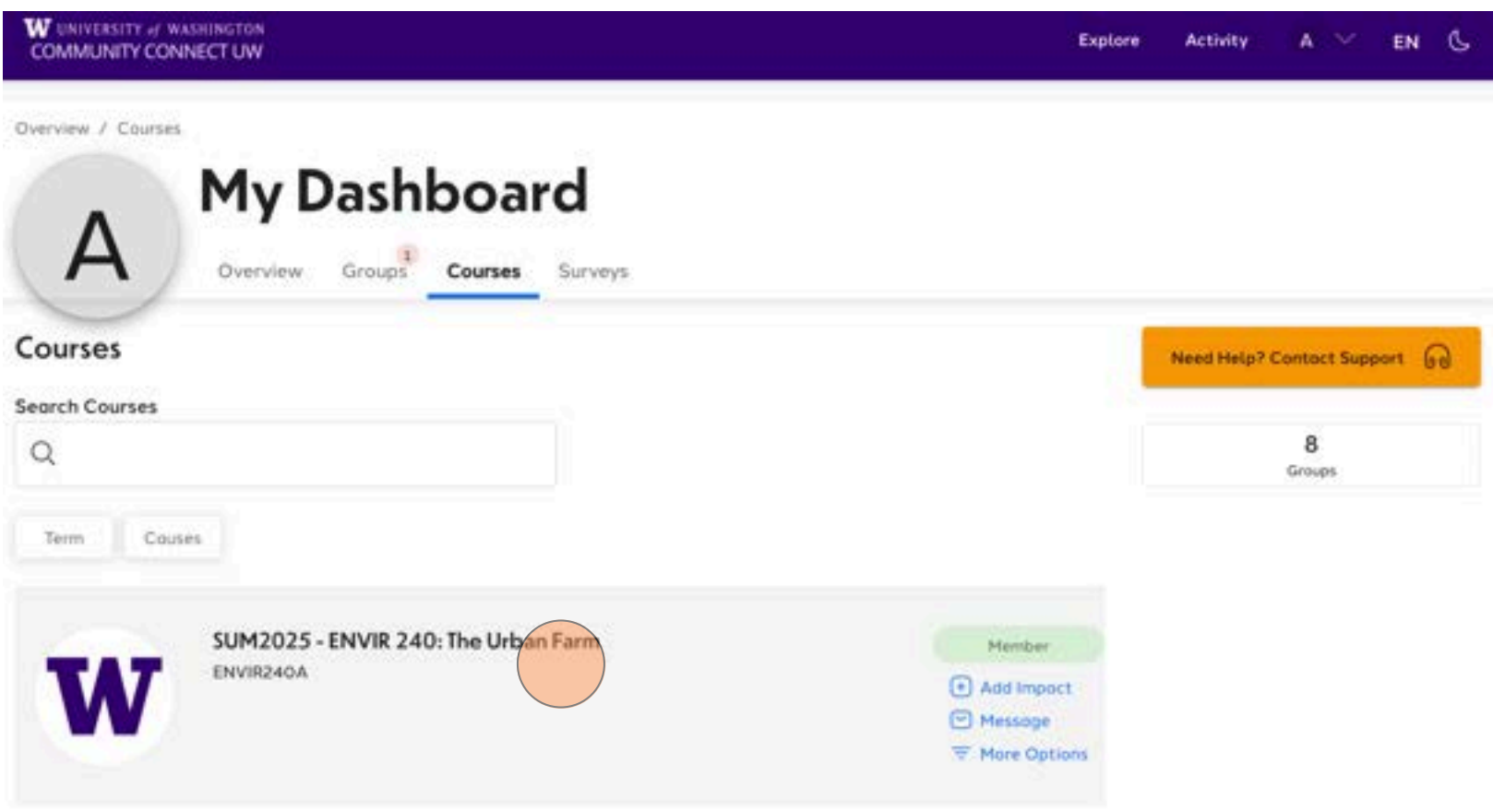
Enter your UW NetID and Password. Click “Sign In” and you will be redirected back to Community Connect UW.

Scroll down to view the opportunities available for your class, then click the one you'd like to register for.

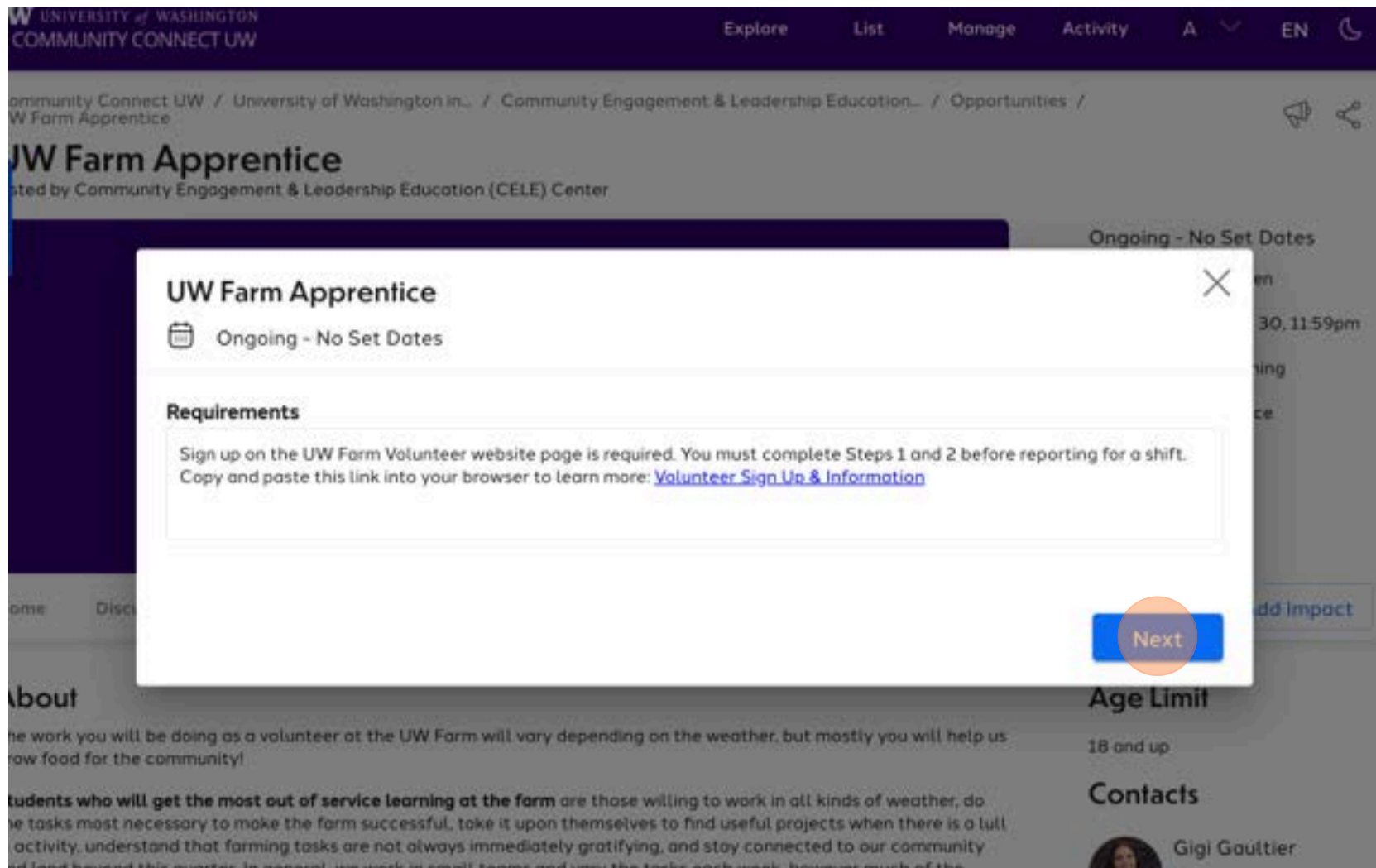

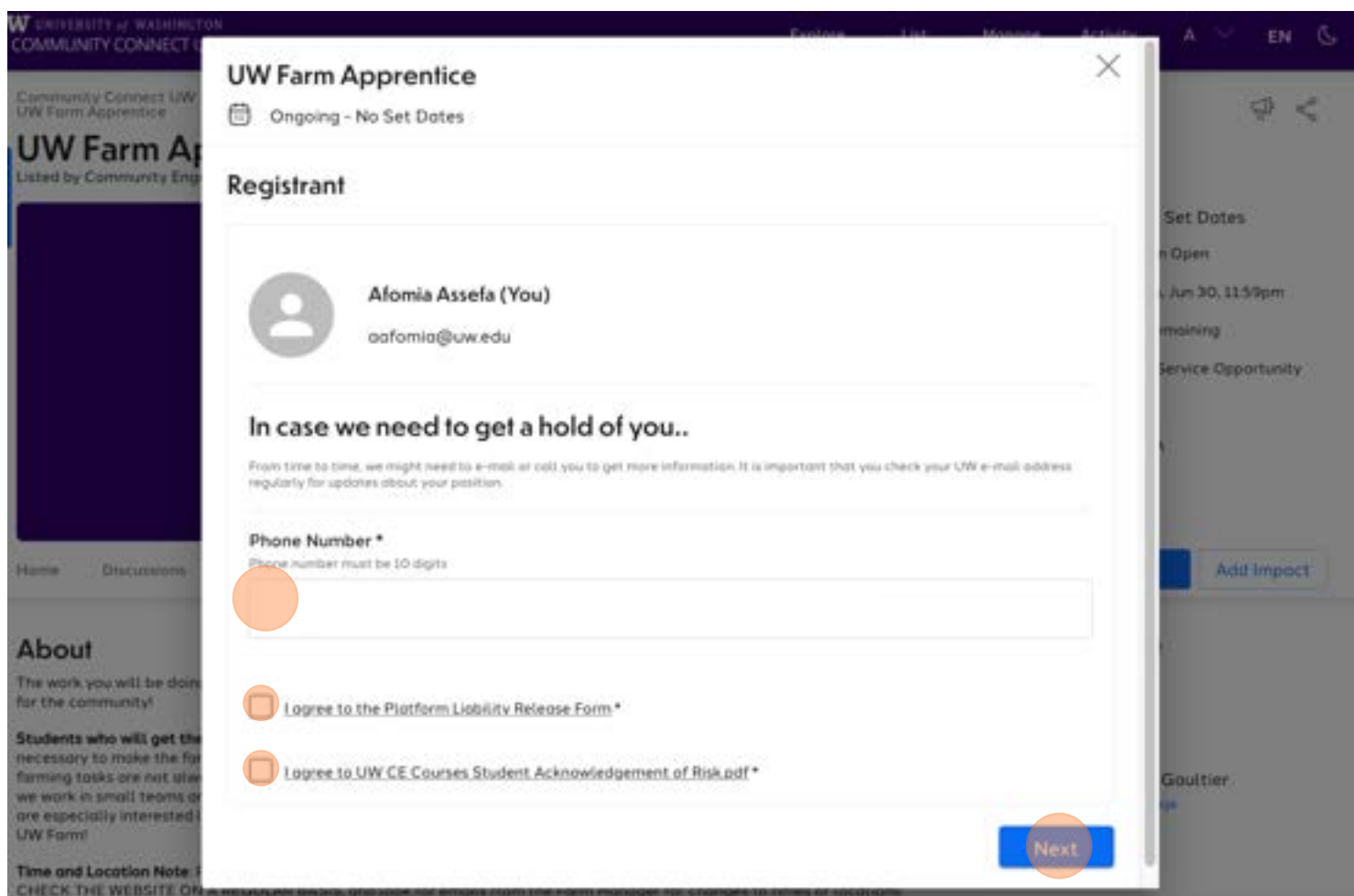
Thoroughly read through the opportunity details and requirements before registering. Once you've reviewed everything, click on "Register" to begin the registration process.


9 Read through the Requirements and click "Next".



10 Confirm your phone number, agree to the Platform Release Form, and acknowledge the UW Community-Engaged Courses Student Risk Agreement and click "Next".




11 Registration is complete.
